◇ Main objective

Is to develop cross-border shoreline oil spill management by joint developing new practical management tools and efficient risk prevention methods, including oil contaminated wildlife response among authorities in Finland, Estonia, Sweden and Russia

◆ **Results of the project**

1) To plan and implement an international oil combating **education** for management level

◆ 2) Guidelines and manuals for cross border cooperation (Based on development projects)

- ◆ 3) To start **actions** for better preparedness and respons (Based on development projects).

## ◆ Other results

18 cooperation agreements are developed and signed among shoreline authorities in the Central Baltic Region of Estonia, Finland, Russia and Sweden

- ❖ Oiled wildlife preparedness is developed with the support of 3 practical trainings (organized in Finland, Estonia & Sweden). A manual about oiled wildlife treatment is published and rehabilitation protocols for the Baltic Sea Region are developed.

- ◆ A curriculum and learning materials for authorities and stakeholders enhanced management level competence are developed and published

- ◆ A training manual of a shoreline hands on exercise to be realized repeatedly is developed and presented for HELCOM

- ◆ 3 international seminars and 11 workshops are organized in Estonia, Finland and Sweden in order to enhance management level shoreline oil spill response cooperation and competence.

## ◆ The project offers

1) International oil combating **education** with special focus in the special features of the Central Baltic in the development needs for better preparedness and response based on the Helcom guidelines and in the development needs identified by operational parties

- ❖ 2) Cross-border **professional** network between authorities and other stakeholders (e.g. harbours).

Competence raising through networking and exchange of best practices (better cooperation).

- ◆ 3) Unique cross-border **development and action forum** for oil combating in the coastal areas.

For the first time all coastal operators from Estonia, Finland, Sweden and Russia are developing “around the same table”

Development work is done by the coastal operators with the assistance of other project partners - > guarantees that the development projects meet real needs
